

Redmine macro cheat sheet



Redmine includes a macro system that allows you to add custom functions to insert dynamic content in formatted text. This cheat sheet displays all currently available Redmine macros.

show_count	If you use the {{count}} macro this one displays the count of the page	{{show_count}}		
taggedpages(tagname)	Displays a list of pages with a specific tag name	{{taggedpages(tagname)}}		
taggedpages(tagname1[,tagname2...,tagnamen], project)	This macro displays the list of pages of projects which have the specified tags	{{taggedpages(tagname1[,tagname2...,tagnamen], project)}}		
tagcloud	Tagcloud macro displays a tag cloud of your tagged wiki pages	{{tagcloud}}

thumbnail	Displays a clickable thumbnail of an attached image	{{thumbnail(image.png)}}	Images & Styles

div_start_tag(id_name)	If you have a wiki page named StyleSheet you can edit the project specific theme and write your CSS in this page. This macro is changed to <div id="id_name">	{{div_start_tag(id_name)}}		
div_start_tag(id_name, class_name)	This macro is changed to <div id="id_name" class="class_name">	{{div_start_tag(id_name, class_name)}}		
div_end_tag	This macro is changed to </div>	{{div_end_tag}}

comment_form	Displays a comment form in a page	{{comment_form}}

recent	Displays the list of pages that were changed or added within the last 5 days	{{recent}}
